This pathway allows students to complete their **Grade 12 to Master's journey** in just 5 years (traditional pathway 7 years minimum) graduating from top North American universities and starting your career **two years ahead of their peers**.

Year 1:

OSSD Grade 12 + DU University Courses

Students complete their OSSD Grade 12 credits at NYA while also taking at least 4 online university courses from DU. This allows them to earn their OSSD high school diploma and a DU university course transcript.

Years 3 & 4:

Bachelor's Degree at Northeastern CPS

Students enroll in their chosen bachelor's degree program at Northeastern University CPS, taking advantage of the credit transfer from their DU associate degree.

START

Year 2:

Completion of DU Associate Degree

Students continue their studies at NYA or partner institutions to complete the remaining courses required for the DU associate degree. Upon successful completion, they gain admission to Northeastern University CPS.

Master's Degree via PlusOne Programs

Qualified students can seamlessly transition into an accelerated master's degree program at Northeastern University, earning a master's degree in as little as one additional year.



FEES & APPLICATION PROCESS

TUITION FEES & SCHOLARSHIPS

- Tuition Fee: \$22,800 CAD/Year
- University Accelerated Pathway Program: \$36,800 CAD/Year
- Ontario Student Insurance: \$650 CAD/Year
- Academic Scholarship: Up to 50% of tuition
- Merit Scholarship: Up to \$6,000 CAD

HOME STAY & GUARDIANSHIP

- Homestay Fees: \$2,000 \$2,500 CAD/Month, including three meals per day and transportation (fees may vary depending on the homestay situation)
- Guardianship: \$2,500 CAD/Month

APPLICATION & ADMISSION PROCESS

Application Materials:

- Complete the application form
- Provide high school transcripts
- Provide passport information page or ID card
- · Application fee: \$200 CAD/Student

Application Process:

- Once all applications materials have been submitted, our admission officers will contact applicant and arrange an interview if needed.
- Once the application has been approved, admissions officer will issue a conditional offer letter and payment notice.
- After receiving tuition payment, our admissions office will issue an
 official admission letter to support visa application if needed.
- Students moving to Canada need to obtain a study permit and visa.
- Students must complete enrolment at North York Academy before designated enrolment deadline.
